- Topic:** **Water Safety Planning (ASHRAE 188-2015) and Microbiological Water Filtration**
It is now, more than ever, imperative for healthcare facilities to develop and manage their own Water Management Programs. The CMS Memorandum entitled Requirement to Reduce Legionella Risk in Healthcare Facility Water Systems to Prevent Cases and Outbreaks of Legionnaires' Disease (LD) will be reviewed along with the CDC Toolkit: Developing a Water Management Program to Reduce Legionella Growth & Spread in Buildings. Strategies to reduce risks of Healthcare Acquired Infections will be introduced and discussed.
- Because every building has unique water systems and therefore a unique mix of requirements regarding contamination control, a comprehensive review of both microbial and particulate water filtration within the healthcare setting will be provided. Filtration removes and retains contaminants from water systems that may adversely affect patients, staff and equipment.
