- I. General knowledge of fire door inspection requirements per NFPA 80 & 101
 - II. Building manager's responsibilities for fire door inspections
 - A. Maintaining fire door assemblies in working condition in accordance with NFPA 80.
 - i. NFPA 80 limits the type of work that can be performed on fire door assemblies.
 - ii. Owner's personnel need to be aware of limitations.
 - III. Responsibilities of a fire door assembly inspector
 - A. Knowledgeable Inspector witness, document and report conditions of fire door assemblies to building owners.
