- TOPIC:** ***WATER AS A SOURCE OF HOSPITAL ACQUIRED INFECTION***  
Controlling Legionella in hospital water systems is key to reducing the risk of hospital-acquired Legionnaires' disease. Preventing outbreaks and protecting patients requires 1) a team approach that includes infection control and engineering, 2) knowledge of Legionella, 3) routine monitoring and early diagnosis and detection and 4) a proactive evidence-based plan so you can respond not react when you find Legionella or other waterborne pathogens in your water system.
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
