TOPIC: **Microbiological Water Filtration from Point of Entry to Point of Use**
Every building has unique water systems and therefore a unique mix of requirements regarding contamination control. Filtration removes and retains contaminants from water systems that may adversely affect patients, staff and equipment. A comprehensive review of both microbial and particulate water filtration within the healthcare setting will be provided. We will discuss opportunities to provide barriers against waterborne microorganisms during outbreak scenarios as well as proactively reducing risk for patient exposures with whole-hospital filtration through sink/shower/ice machine filters.
