TOPIC:

HVAC System Performance Requirements - Where OSHPD, ASHRAE and TJC Collide

This presentation describes where agencies such as OSHPD, The Joint Commission, ASHRAE are similar and where they are different when it comes to HVAC system performance in hospitals. We will look at the applicable sections of the California Mechanical Code, The Environment of Care Standard and ASHRAE 170, compare and contrast rules and discuss the increased regulatory focus on the issue of pressure relationships, temperature and humidity.
